



Volunteers and Spectators Codes of Conduct

As a volunteer/spectator in any activity held by or under the auspices of the Eagles Baseball Club Inc, a member association, or an affiliated club, volunteers and spectators must meet the following requirements regarding conduct during any such activity or event.

Breaches of these codes will result in disciplinary action to be determined by Eagles Baseball Clubs Disciplinary Action Code.

VOLUNTEERS and SPECTATORS are required to:

- Act as good role models and ambassadors for the club always.
- Always welcome opposition players, spectators, officials etc. to the Club.
- Never use offensive language or behaviour.
- Treat everyone, including the opposition, with respect regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, or religion.
- Display consistently high standards of good sporting behaviour including respecting the official's decisions.
- Adhere to the smoke-free policies of the club.
- Not to consume alcohol in any place other than where the club's license allows
- Adhere to and support the Club policies.
- Do not speak about or bring the committee or club into disrepute.
- Be trustworthy.
